The weekly program was devised to have Clark soccer players help the students with their writing skills and stress the importance of working hard and setting goals, both in athletics and in the class room. In addition, the kids broke up into smaller work groups and were given writing assignments from their teachers, which the Clark players oversaw. "When we walk in, you just see their faces light up," said Clark junior Jen Scavone of Worcester, who works with the fourth-graders. The five-month program culminated with a soccer clinic for all the kids at Clark. "The players made a real commitment to the program every week and were dedicated to helping the students at the Mill Swan School," Brady said. The first year was extremely successful and we look forward to continuing the program next year."
