### Crunch Time

Having dropped back-to-back games and seven of their last eight contests, Clark enters a critical part of their 2009-10 schedule with two crucial home contests this week beginning with Wednesday night's tilt with Wheaton.

### Second Coming

The Lyons won the first matchup this season, 76-52, thanks in part to a 35-5 run to end the first half. Wheaton took 24 more shots than Clark largely because of the 28 Cougar turnovers and made 11 of their 30 three-point attempts.

### On The Outside

If the NEWMAC Tournament began play today, the Cougars would be on the outside looking in. They enter their matchup with the Lyons in a tie for eighth place with Coast Guard at 3-9 in league play. The Bears knocked off Clark 61-58 in overtime back on January 9 to gain control of the tiebreaker. The rematch is scheduled for the final regular season game on January 20.

### Thinking Pink

Saturday will mark the women's basketball program's annual Pink Zone event. Sponsored in conjunction with Cougar Pride and the WBCA (Women's Basketball Coaches Association), the first 25 individuals with Clark ID's will receive a free t-shirt. In addition, all monies collected for admission into Saturday's game will be donated to the Kay Yow/WBCA Cancer Fund.

### Dime Dropper Extraordinaire

Wheaton College senior **Andrea Bailey** became the program's all-time leader in assists on January 20. She broke the 20-year old record in a 61-49 loss to Wellesley in a 10-point, seven-rebound five assist performance. She enters the matchup with the Cougars having handed out 450 career helpers.

### Milestone In The Making?

Clark senior **Jillian Camilleri** (Lancaster, Mass.) enters the contest against the Lyons with 989 career points. If she reaches her season scoring average of 11.4 points, she would become the 17th member of the Clark women's basketball 1,000 point club.

### 50 Below

In all four of Clark's wins this season they have held their opponent to 51 points or fewer. Three of those victories came when they held opponents to 45 points or less.

### Home Court Advantage?

In their most recent four-game homestand the Cougars were outscored 515-439. An average of 24.5 points per game.
