1/3 mile in eight-oared shells

1. The two crews will row past the float (Crompton & Knowles Park) so that the judges may select the crew showing the best oarsmanship and coordination.
2. The crews will line up at the starting line off the float and race 1/3 mile south to the finish line off the point at Columbus Park.

Radcliffe will be in white and will row in the shore (East) lane.

Clark will be in red and row in the outer (west) lane.

The winners color will be raised at the finish of the race.

5:00 P.M. South High School Girls vs Clark Freshman Girls
1/3 mile in four-oared shells

South High will row in the shore lane.

Clark (red) will row in the outer lane (furthest from shore).

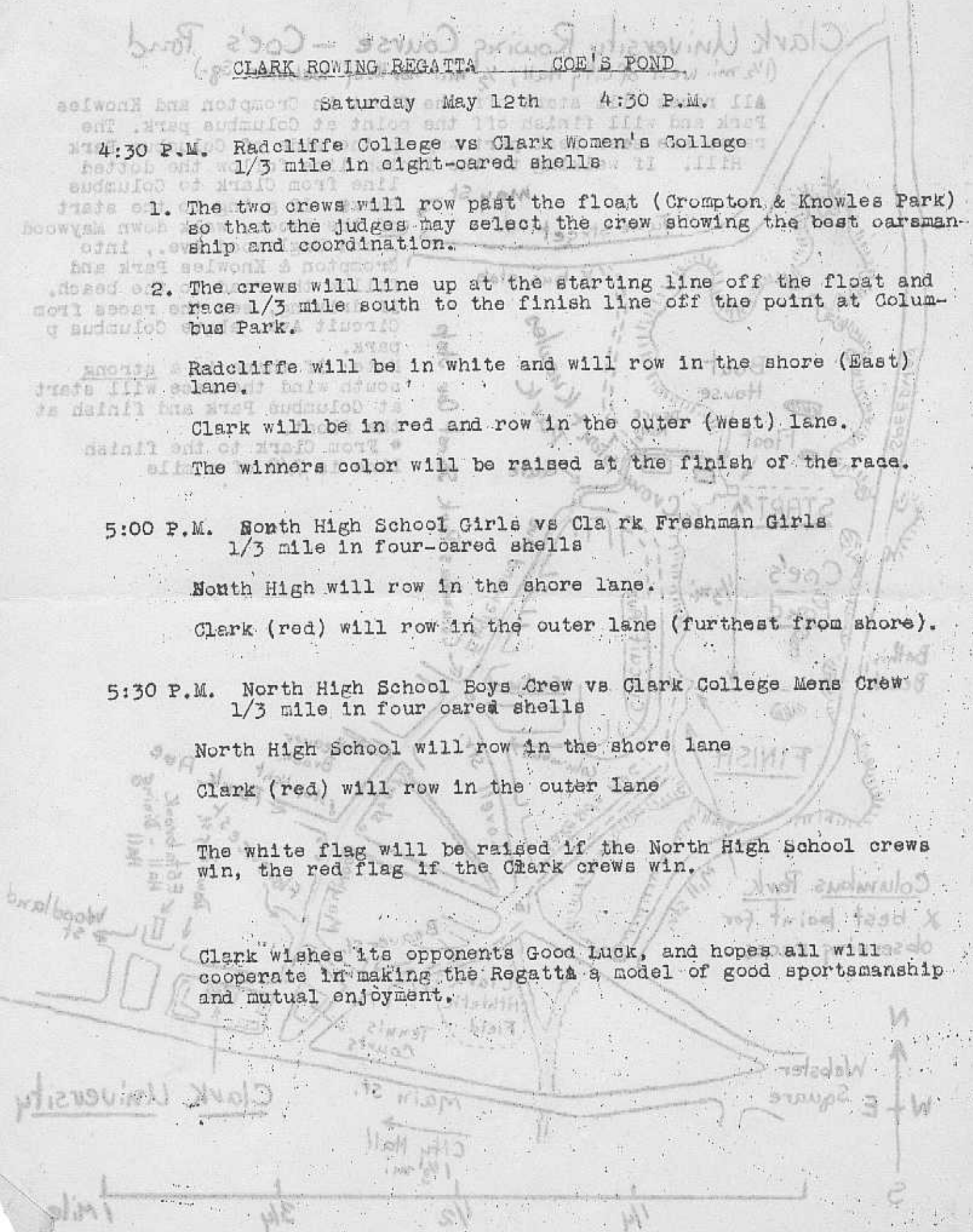
5:30 P.M. North High School Boys Crew vs Clark College Mens Crew

Clark University Rowing Course - Coe's Pond

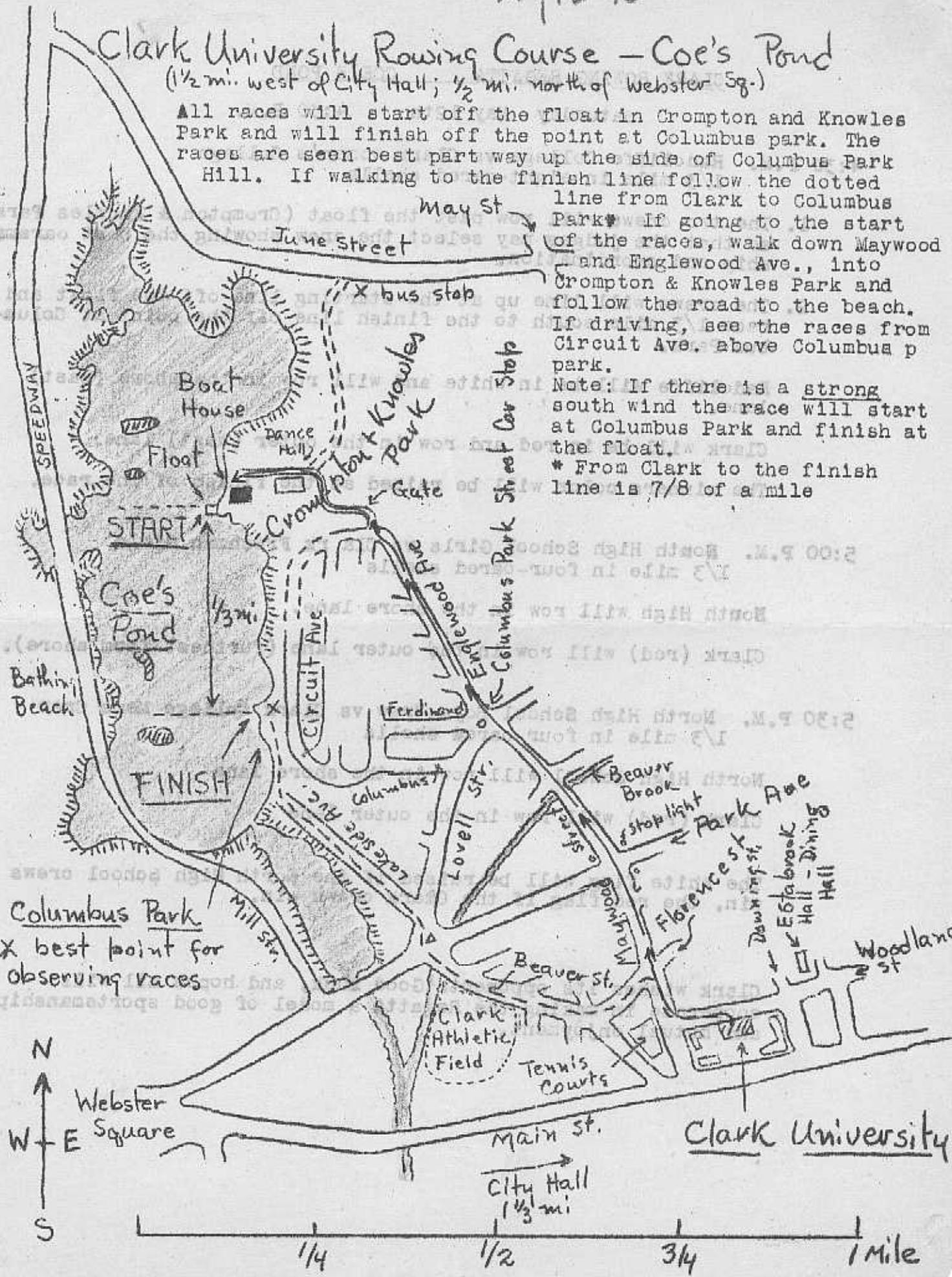
(1/2 mi. west of City Hall; 1/2 mi. north of Webster Sq.)

All races will start off the float in Crompton and Knowles Park and will finish off the point at Columbus park. The races are seen best part way up the side of Columbus Park Hill. If walking to the finish line follow the dotted line from Clark to Columbus Park.

If going to the start of the races, walk down Maywood and Englewood Ave., into Crompton & Knowles Park and follow the road to the beach. If driving, see the races from Circuit Ave. above Columbus park.

Note: If there is a strong south wind the race will start at Columbus Park and finish at the float.

* From Clark to the finish line is 7/8 of a mile
