Dear Gene:

In connection with the funds held in the name of the Regatta Committee of Worcester, Judge Wahlstrom has entered the following decree:

*Court Decree*

"After hearing and consideration, the Court orders and decrees that Linwood M. Erskine, Jr., be appointed trustee of the funds of the Regatta Committee and that he is authorized and directed to expend not more than two hundred dollars for the purchase of a suitable trophy or trophies, these to be used as awards in rowing competitions on Lake Quinsigamond and to be known as the Regatta Committee Trophy with the competition for said trophy and the awarding thereof to be administered by a committee appointed by the President of Clark University, and it is further decreed that after the payment of costs and expenses the balance of the fund is to be paid to Clark University and is to be used toward the purchase of a rowing shell for the use of the crew of said University."

The pass book covering the account is missing and as yet I have not applied to the bank for a duplicate. I suppose that this may take some time as usually the banks require newspaper publication and a waiting period before a duplicate is issued.

If you expect to be downtown at any time within the next few weeks, I would appreciate your telephoning me so that I could arrange to discuss with you the purchase of trophies.
