

IDSC Honor's Thesis Calendar and Checklist

Junior Year

Fall

- Attend Honor's Program information session (details to be announced).

Spring

- Turn in draft of thesis proposal to thesis advisor by the first Friday after spring break. A second draft is due March 25th.
- April 15th—Submit Honor's thesis application to the IDSC Undergraduate Program Coordinator.
- May 1st—Undergraduate Program Coordinator notifies student of preliminary approval, rejection, or need for revision and resubmission.

Senior Year

Fall

- Register for ID 290 and begin work on Honor's Thesis in consultation with thesis advisors.
- October 1st—Submit a two-page progress report to thesis advisor and IDSC Undergraduate Coordinator.

December 1st—Present a draft chapter, detailed outline, and a full bibliography to the thesis advisor, who in turn, recommends continuation or withdrawal.

Spring

- Register for ID 297 Honor's Thesis with thesis advisor.
- February—Present a complete draft of entire thesis to thesis advisor.
- March 1st—Submit a final draft of thesis, including any revisions suggested by the advisor, to the advisor and second reader.
- March 30th—Deadline for oral defense and Honor's recommendation to IDSC program faculty.
- April 15th—Deadline for final Honor's thesis submitted to IDSC Undergraduate Coordinator.
- April (date to be determined)—Participate in Academic Spree Day.
