BANK STATEMENT / AFFIDAVIT OF SUPPORT

* This amount (TUITION & FEES) represents tuition for **seven full course units per academic year** plus the student services fee of **\$1,600** (paid one-time only). [The tuition for one full course unit at the Graduate School of Management is **\$3,600.**] Full-time international students are required to take a minimum of three full course units per semester, for a total minimum of six full course units per academic year (fall and spring semesters). **It is estimated that most full-time students take at least seven full course units per academic year, and many students take eight.**
