

IMMUNIZATION ALERT!!

OUTBREAKS ACROSS U.S.A. ON COLLEGE CAMPUSES

Massachusetts law requires that all students be given a second dose of live measles vaccine, preferably an MMR (Measles, Mumps, and Rubella) before entering college. Massachusetts law also requires 3 doses of Hepatitis B vaccine.

REQUIRED: Two (2) doses of MMR vaccine (one after 12 months of age and one booster)
Td (tetanus and diphtheria booster within 10 years)
Tuberculosis risk assessment/PPD if required
Three (3) doses of Hepatitis B vaccine
Meningococcal Vaccine for serogroups A, C, Y, W135 or signed waiver form

RECOMMEND: Varicella (chicken pox) *Please note students who are not appropriately immunized or are without laboratory evidence of immunity or a reliable history of chicken pox may be excluded from school if they have been exposed.
Human Papilloma Virus (HPV) for females.

CLARK HEALTH SERVICE CHECKLIST

To ensure your smooth registration as you complete each item, check it off the following list. **The completed forms must be returned to the Health Service by July 15 for the fall semester and by the registration date for January semester.**

1. Health history (part A). Please complete in full.
 - A. Have you included the name of an alternate person residing at a different address other than your parent or guardian?
 - B. Have you included your insurance information? **Massachusetts law mandates that all students must be enrolled in a qualified student health insurance plan.** You may choose to participate in either the plan offered by Clark University or another comparable plan. For information regarding insurance, please visit our web site at www.clarku.edu/offices/health. Please be sure to obtain an insurance card for use in case of an emergency. **You are required to send a copy of the front and back of your card with these forms.**
 - C. Is the medical emergency consent signed?
 - D. Are all items on page 2 answered?
2. Is the immunization record complete? Please have this completed prior to arriving on campus to avoid additional charges and delay of registration.
 - A. Have you received two (2) doses of MMR?
 - B. Have you received three doses of Hepatitis B?
 - C. Have you completed the meningococcal vaccine requirement? Enclosed is the meningococcal information sheet and waiver. For more information on this vaccine please contact the Clark Health Service at 950 Main St., Worcester, MA 01610-1477. Telephone 508-793-7467.
3. Has your health care provider completed all items on the physical exam sheet?
4. If you plan to receive allergy injections at Clark, we will require certain information from your allergist. **Please note that the health service does not administer desensitization injections for insect stings which require venom.** Please call or write to Clark Health Service for written procedures at the phone number or address above.
