### I. Internet Sites

***PopNet: The Source for Global Population Information*** is a directory of population-related web sites. PopNet is maintained by the Population Reference Bureau with partial funding from USAID. (<http://www.popnet.org>)

As is now well understood, the analytical power of GIS can be applied to any spatially referenced data. ***GIS and Archaeology*** has a number of links to Internet resources on the applications of GIS to archaeological research. (<http://www.peak.org/~skinnrc/pipslist.html>)

The Israel Ministry of Foreign Affairs has recently mounted an exhibition on the cartographic history of Jerusalem. An Internet version, ***Jerusalem in Old Maps and Views***, allows those who are not able to attend the exhibit, an opportunity to view selections from it. As an outgrowth of researching the environmental, social, and economic impacts of dams, the Environmental Defense Fund has created a site, ***Dams Around the World***, which provides a map and list (with descriptions) of about 50 projects. A site already listed in the "Links" section of Map Library's home page but which deserves a second look for its recently added material is ***UNEP's GRID-Arendal*** page. In addition to the digital data sets for the world, Africa, and the Arctic, you will find informative "State of the Environment Reports" for countries in Central and Eastern Europe. There is a "Maps and Graphics" section which contains 114 environment-related items searchable by subject or geographic area. The EPA has added a ***Grant-Writing Tutorial*** to its site. Although specifically designed for people applying for EPA grants, this resource features material that might prove useful to anyone applying for a grant.
