GOLD Gives



End of Year

It has been an incredible year for Clark. The generosity of Clark's alumni community has made the following developments possible this year:

- The University launched its first-ever Honors Experience, co-designed by students and faculty to strengthen Clark's reputation for academic excellence in a competitive higher education landscape.
- The Becker School of Design & Technology at Clark was ranked 3rd in the world in Princeton Review's Top 50 Schools for Game Design, while our Master of Fine Arts program was No. 7 in the Top 25 Graduate Schools for Game Design. Both programs are ranked No. 2 among schools in the Northeast.
- U.S. News & World Report ranked Clark's School of Management No. 96 among the Best Business Schools – Full-Time MBA Programs — in the country with SOM jumping ten spots from No. 106 last year.
- Applications for admission for the Class of 2028 topped 11,400, including students from all 50 states for the second year in a row!
- Clark's new School for Climate, Environment, and Society received a \$10 million pledge.
 The new school will address one of the most urgent and profound global issues of our time.
