
Using Goddard Library Databases to Capture RIS Citation Files for Upload to Clark eFolio

Step 1: Navigate to a database that includes citations to your published work.

- A. Visit http://www2.clarku.edu/research/goddard/
- B. Follow the link to 'All Databases'

Step 2: Search for your publication(s) and review the full record.

- A. While JSTOR is the example database, similar procedures may be used to obtain your .RIS citation files from other library databases as well as Google Scholar.
- B. Look for language or images leading to citation data; in the case of JSTOR you will see 'Cite this item':



C. Look for language indicating you may export or download citation data. Look for .RIS and download the file to your computer.

Step 3: Upload .RIS file to Clark eFolio.
