United Rentals offers approximately 4,000 classes of equipment for rent with a total original cost of \$14.13 billion. Craig will discuss his background, his view of the key challenges in leading people today, career advice (e.g., what skills do they need to develop now, what kinds of experiences are valuable to employers, mistakes that young professionals commonly make), issues around change, and diversity, equity & inclusion in the workplace.


