## COVID Testing Continues This Fall

Clark is reintroducing COVID-19 surveillance testing to start the fall semester. All vaccinated Clark employees working on campus will be part of a once-a-week testing protocol, conducted through the Broad Institute. Those who received vaccination exemptions must test twice weekly.

Testing, which involves a self-administered nasal swab, will take place in the Grace and Lurie conference rooms on the ground floor of the Higgins University Center; testing hours are 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday, and 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Wednesday.

## Fall Semester Update from Mail Services

Staff from University offices and departments should pick up and drop off their mail and packages at the Department Mailroom, located next to the Main Mailroom in the basement of the University Center (take the elevator across from the Information Desk, or the stairway that is just past it). Both mailrooms are open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 3 p.m.

The student mailroom, on the second floor of the UC, will be open Monday through Friday from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m., and Saturday from 11 a.m. to 3 p.m.

During the first three weeks of the semester, the mailrooms will be open from 8 a.m. to 8 p.m., Monday through Thursday; 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Friday, and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Saturday.
